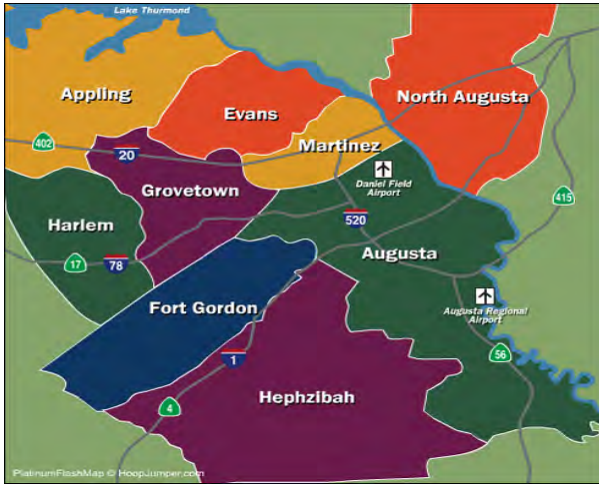

AUGUSTA OVERVIEW

Located on the Georgia/South Carolina border, Augusta lies on the Savannah River. Augusta is the center point of the CSRA (Central Savannah River Area), a 13 county region that includes Georgia and South Carolina. The city's famous golf course, the Augusta National Golf Club, hosts the first major golf tournament of each year, The Masters. Major highways of Interstate 20 and Interstate 520 serve the region with access to major cities such as Atlanta, Columbia, Charlotte, Charleston and Savannah. The county has an area of 1,490 square miles. Augusta is served by Augusta Regional Airport and Daniel Field (serving private aircraft).

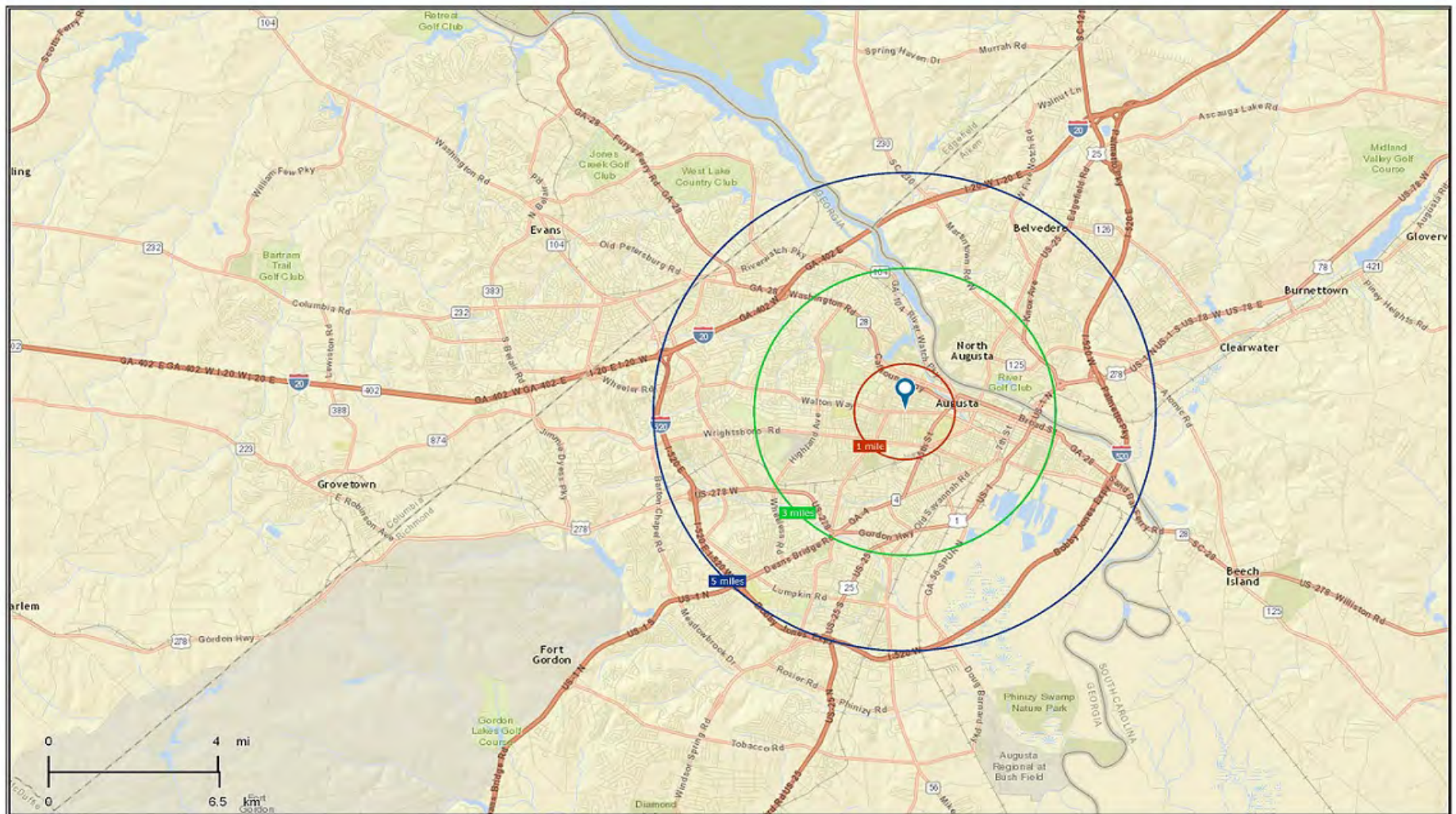
